They were the impact on access to businesses, the ability for First Responders to access homes and businesses, public safe-

access homes and businesses, public safe access formes and businesses, public sate-ty because of the traffic patterns, increase of traffic on the side streets, the added mainte-nance for the green space, and the general aesthetics. Travis Dillman from Interstate Engineering was present with comments about the side street traffic, business access for semi-trailer trucks, using a private drive for public access, and access for the First Responders. The advances for removing the frontage roads were few as most were to be addressed in the original project were to be addressed in the original project proposed by the city. 


