MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING NEW ROCKFORD CITY COMMISSION NEW ROCKFORD, NORTH DAKOTA February 20, 2018

President Packard called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. in City Hall with Commissioners Richter, Allmaras, McKnight, Ellington, and PWS Hichert present. All purpose of the meeting was to discuss the proposed ND Department of Transportation frontage road closures in the city. Allmaras moved to reply to the North Dakota Department of Transportation with a letter stating the City of New Rockford is opposed to the North Dakota Department of Transportation proposal to close most of the frontage roads adjacent to Highway 281. Richter seconded. The subject was opened to discussion. There were fifteen residents and business owners in attendance. When asked, all the residents and business owners indicated that they were opposed to closing the frontage roads.

President Packard presented a list of reasons for not closing the frontage roads. They were the impact on access to businesses, the ability for First Responders to access homes and businesses, public safety because of the traffic patterns, increase of traffic on the side streets, the added maintenance for the green space, and the general aesthetics. Travis Dillman from Interstate Engineering was present with comments about the side street traffic, business access for semi-trailer trucks, using a private drive for public access, and access for the First Responders. The advances for removing the frontage roads were few as most were to be addressed in the original project proposed by the city. Dillman expressed that closing the frontage roads was not in the city's best interest.

Residents remarks included there would be no access to businesses fuel pumps and shops, using a private drive for public use and who would be responsible for maintenance, parking for trucks and trailers when in the businesses, loss of business due to no parking, semi-trucks and trailers not being able to access the businesses, and access to private homes. After all had a chance to be heard, the motion was put to a vote. In the roll call vote, it was all in favor of the motion. Motion was declared carried. A letter will be drafted to the North Dakota Department of Transportation. With no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:18 p.m. Minutes are subject to approval at the next regular Board meeting. Published March 5, 2018
