Woodpiles should be checked for elm wood right away. Any elm wood with the bark still attached should be separated out of the pile and burned before April 1.

Please help in saving elm trees in New Rockford and burn or destroy all elm wood in your piles before April 1. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.



•A bighorn sheep hunting season is scheduled to open in 2018, unless there is a recurrence of bacterial pneumonia. Applicants may apply for a license at this time, but not in a specific unit. The status of the bighorn sheep season will be determined

Total elk licenses increased by 19 to 408.

• Total moose licenses increased by 89 to a record 334. Most of the license increases are antlerless licenses in Units M10 and M11.

 All moose licensees and Unit E1E, E1W, E2, and E6 elk licensees may hunt during both the Bow Season and the Regular Season until license is filled. Moose Hunting Units M1C and M4 will remain closed in 2018.


