Glenda Collier made a motion to approve the transfer of funds of \$25,000 from County General to County Agent. Jeff Pfau seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Jeff Pfau made a motion to approve the sheriff's report for the month of March 2018 and it was seconded by Glenda Collier. The motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS: Irvin Loe, Road Superintendent, gave an update on the road department. The February snowplowing bill for Cherry Lake Township was discussed.

NEW BUSINESS: The Commissioners reviewed the letter from Finley Engineering Company, Inc. regarding procurement of right-of-way easements and permits with NDTC for the 2018 fiber optic upgrade in the Warwick and Sheyenne Exchanges. Glenda Collier made a motion to sign the permits. Jeff Pfau seconded the motion and the motion carried.

The Commissioners reviewed the letter from the ND Highway Patrol regarding assistance with enforcement of the 2018 spring load restrictions on county roads, and year-round assistance as time and resources permit. Jeff Pfau made a motion to request both spring load restrictions assistance and year-round assistance. Glenda Collier seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Signs for the different departments in the courthouse were discussed. Options for department signs will be brought to the next meeting for review.

The amendment to the 2017 Eddy County Zoning Ordinance regarding medical marijuana was handed out. The public hearing on the amendment will be held on April 10, 2018, 1:00 P.M., in the courthouse basement.

The need for new lighting at the Social Services building was discussed. Glenda Collier will contact Taverna Electric to put together an estimate for new LED lighting for that building.

Steve Thompson and Ben Aaseht, Interstate Engineering, Inc., attended the meeting to discuss the grade raise project (site 4) on the Lake Washington road. County road #8. Glenda Collier made a motion to sign the Agreement for Construction Engineering Services with Interstate Engineering, Inc. Jeff Pfau seconded the motion and the motion carried. Jeff Pfau made a motion to approve Progressive Estimate #1 for Harvey Sand and Gravel, Inc. in the amount of \$4,706.10. Glenda Collier seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Neal Rud, Chairperson, adjourned the meeting at 10:20 A.M.

ABBREVIATED NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

relating to the Establishment of the Department Of Environmental Quality

North Dakota Department of Health and the Environmental Health Section Chief, on behalf of the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality

will hold a public hearing to address proposed changes to the N.D. Admin. Code and state implementation plan for air pollution control:

The proposed changes are the adoption of N.D. Admin. Code arts. 33.1-03, 33.1-10, 33.1-15, 33.1-17, 33.1-18, 33.1-19, 33.1-20, 33.1-23, 33.1-24, 33.1-34, and 33.1-35.

Some of the rules in Article 33.1-15 will be submitted to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency as a revision to the State Implementation Plan (SIP) for air pollution control as required by the Federal Clean Air Act. The public hearing will address these rules and other SIP revisions and documentation for approval/delegation of air pollution programs for the Department of Environmental Quality. This includes programs that implement the New Source Performance Standards, Title V Permit to Operate, Acid Rain requirements, Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants, Asbestos Accreditation, and the Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Source Categories.
