Commissioner Jeff Pfau joined the meeting at 8:55 A.M.
NEW BUSINESS: Glenda Collier made a motion to agree to the general maintenance schedule with Interstate Power for the county's generators as proposed by Todd Allmaras. Jeff Pfau seconded the motion and the motion carried.

The Commissioners reviewed the dues from Northern Plains Resource Conservation and Development and decided not to renew them for 2018.
The County Superintendent of Schools position and NDCC 15.1-11 were reviewed. The superintendent of public instruction will be asked for the form and written approval for the county to eliminate this position.

Jeff Pfau made a motion to sell the unused emergency manager cell phone to Kristy O'Connor for \$113. Glenda Collier seconded the motion and the motion carried.

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING NEW ROCKFORD CITY COMMISSION NEW ROCKFORD, NORTH DAKOTA JUNE 26, 2018

ORGANIZATION MEETING
President Packard called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall with Commissioners Richter, McKnight, newly elected Commissioner Ryan Hager, PWS Hichert and City Attorney Peterson present.

The Auditor reviewed the election results with the Board. For the two 4-year Commission seats, it was Ryan Hager receiving 276 votes, DeVon Allmaras receiving 169 votes, and there were 39 write-in votes. For the three seats on the Park District, it was Jonathan Fortney with 269 votes, Reed Weisenburger with 131 votes, Elliot Belquist with 124 votes and 67 write-in votes.

Newly Elected Ryan Hager was given the North Dakota Oath of Office.
McKnight moved to appoint Richter as Vice President. Hager seconded. All voted

in favor. Motion carried.
Richter moved to appoint Travis Peterson as City Attorney. Hager seconded. President Packard stated that Ashley Lies was also interested in the appointment. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

McKnight moved to appoint George Ritzke as City Auditor. Richter seconded. Motion carried.
Hager moved to appoint Kristy O'Connor as City Assessor. Richter seconded. Motion carried.

Richter moved to remove Amy Ellingson and DeVon Allmaras from the Bank Forward, Community Credit Union, and Bank of North Dakota accounts. McKnight seconded. All voted in favor. Motion carried.
Richter moved to place Calvin Packard, Stuart Richter, Kelly McKnight, Ryan Hager, and City Auditor George Ritzke on the Bank Forward, Community Credit Union, and Bank of North Dakota accounts. McKnight seconded. Motion carried.

Due to the death of DeVon Allmaras, her seat was declared vacant. The Board reviewed the North Dakota Century Code on filling vacancies in the board. The Board decided to appoint a resident to the Board.

Assigning portfolios was next on the agenda. Richter moved to assign the portfolios as follows: Packard, Finance and Airport; Richter, Street; McKnight, Water; and Hager, Economic Development. McKnight seconded. Motion carried. The library portfolio will be not assigned at this time. Packard will temporarily cover the library portfolio.

With no other business, Richter moved to adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 7:21 p.m.
