2018 FALL WILD TURKEY HUNTING PROCLAMATION SUMMARY

The North Dakota Game & Fish Department announces the following summary of regulations and changes for the 2018 Fall Wild Turkey hunting season.

- Licenses will be issued by a weighted lottery procedure. Applications may be submitted online or by phone. Only residents may apply. The deadline for submitting online or phone applications is September 5, 2018.
- The season will run from October 13, 2018 through January 6, 2019.
- The bag limit will be one wild turkey of any sex or age per license.
- Turkeys may be legally taken with shotguns, muzzleloading long guns, certain handguns, and bow and arrow.

Regular license fees apply with no service charge added. Visa, Discover, MasterCard and American Express accepted. Besides license fee, a \$4.00 service charge for each applicant will be added.

### SUMMARY OF CHANGES FROM LAST YEAR

- Total licenses available increased to 3,710 (up from 3,505). Additional licenses, up to a maximum of 1,300, may be issued for specific hunting units.
- Unit 53 (which has been closed to fall turkey hunting), will be open in 2018.
- Unit 21 and Unit 47 will be closed to fall turkey hunting in 2018.
