There was an issue of the cast iron pipes breaking when the water service pump was turned on to replace the water tower. Residents may see some pressure fluctuations. The water plant is moving forward with some concerns over the land purchase and railroad easements. The title opinion will need to be cleared up before awarding a contract. A completion date was discussed. Richter moved to approve the water plant plans, proceed to bidding with a completion date of 16 months and USDA approval. Ystaas seconded. In a roll call vote, all voted to approve. Motion carried.

Jon Heinz was present for the New Rockford Eagles Club. The Eagles is requesting to block 8th Street off from July 2 to July 5 for a groom's supper and the July 4 feed. Ystaas moved to approve the Eagles Club to block 8th Street off. Hager seconded. The businesses affected will be contacted. Motion carried. Hager moved to approve the Special Permit for those days. Richter seconded. Motion carried.

Justin McDonald was present about blocking 9th Street for street dance on July 2. Ystaas moved to allow Justin McDonald to block 9th Street and issue him a Special Permit. Hager second. Motion carried.

Dakota Prairie Regional Center for the Arts was requesting to block Central Avenue off in front of their building at 818 Central Avenue for concerts on June 14, 28, July 12, 26, and August 9. Hager moved to approve Dakota Prairie Regional Center for the Arts to block Central Avenue on the foresaid dates. Ystaas seconded. Motion carried.

The Board discussed the proposal from DEA to relocate some wiring on the water tower. The General Contractor is responsible for these expenses per the contract. The proposal will be forwarded to the General Contractor. No action taken.

PWS Hirschert was present with his monthly report. The major items were the water plant generator is being installed and the water plant windows are done. The pressure relief valve did not work at the water tower so the city had four water main breaks due to high pressure. The plan is to use some millings from the highway project on 3rd Street NE. Tall grass nuisance letters are being sent out. Hager moved to accept the report. Ystaas seconded. Motion carried.

Commissioner Richter gave an update on the NDDOT Highway 281 utilities conflicts. Naastad Brothers has settled with the NDDOT for a partial payment. There is about \$15,000 left to be paid. No action was taken.

McKnight moved to approve the partial payment estimate of \$494,014.25 for BEK Consulting. Richter seconded. In a roll call vote, all voted to approve. Motion carried.

Ystaas moved to approve building permits for Brittany Jacobson, shingles; M&J Rentals, sidewalk and kitchen floor; Connie Ystaas, shingles and painting; and Duane Duda, 24x24 house addition. Hager seconded. Motion carried.

McKnight moved to approve housing incentives for Joyce Pistol. Hager seconded. Motion carried.

Hager moved to sell Lot 27 and E22' of Lot 28, Block 28 of Original Townsite to William J. Fleming for \$330. Ystaas seconded. Motion carried.

Richter moved to approve the annual gaming site authorizations for the New Rockford Eagles at Buck-Its Bar, New Rockford Eagles for the Eagles Club, New Rockford Lions Club for Hanson's Bar, and Eddy County Rod and Gun Club. Ystaas seconded. Motion carried.
