The application requests a permit to appropriate water from ground water, utilizing point(s) of diversion located in the SW1/4 of Section 12 and NW1/4 of Section 13, Township 150 N., Range 063 W., Eddy County, at a pumping rate of 1,600 gallons per minute during the operating season for each year said water permit may remain in force, with an annual appropriation of 305.4 acre-feet of water, for the purpose of irrigating 203.6 acres of land located in the SW1/4 of Section 12 and NW1/4 of Section 13, Township 150 N., Range 063 W., Eddy County, as shown on the map(s) accompanying the application.

Rob Johnson, Lake Region Law Enforcement Center, presented the preliminary 2021 budget requests for the Law Enforcement Center, the Reentry Center, and E911 and explained the formulas used to determine Eddy County's share of these requests.

The Commissioners reviewed the Joint Powers Agreement, Police Service Contracts, held with the City of New Rockford and City of Sheyenne. After some discussion, Glenda Collier made a motion to increase each contract 5% for 2021. Neal Rud seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Glenda Collier explained a request she received for a traffic sign on Highway 281 that would prohibit the use of air brakes. She has been in contact with the ND Highway Department, and they requested an ordinance be put in place so that they can enforce it.
