Motion carried. McKnight moved to approve payment of the following bills. Richter seconded. In a roll call vote, all voted to approved. Motion carried.

Wade Senger from Interstate Engineering was on the conference telephone with a update to the water project. The water mains are scheduled to be done end of September. Concrete and paving to be done mid October. Senger is still waiting on the

easement paperwork from BNSF Railroad. Hager moved to pay a partial payment to BEK Consulting for \$897,611.30. Belquist seconded. In a roll call vote, all voted to approve. Motion carried. Classic Protective Coatings has completed the water tower. There is a one-year warranty on the water tower. Richter moved to pay Classic Protective Coatings final payment for \$41,639.62 and to approve the change order of -\$22,665.51. McKnight seconded. In a roll call vote, all voted to approved. Motion carried. The final papers for signatures will be sent. Commissioner Ystaas made the meeting at 7:10. Hager moved to have President Richter sign the final papers. Ystaas seconded. Motion carried. USDA approved the contract for the water plant. The contract will be forwarded to North Star for their signature. The preconstruction meeting will be this month as North Star wished to start this fall.

Christopher Beggs, NDDOT was on the conference telephone about the Highway 281 project. The Commissioners had several concerns. DOT is getting costs to move the crosswalk pole further to the south. The contractor will be back to fix the erosion, reseed and pick the 4" or larger rocks. The dip on the end of 1st Street south will be researched for drainage issues. The straw wattles will be left until the grass has a 70% coverage, which could be next spring. The drainage on the west side will be looked at when the contractor is back. A new pole may be needed as well as rain caps for the poles. Hager moved to pay \$18,806.46 to NDDOT for the Highway 281 project. Ystaas seconded. Motion carried.

Mike Jacobson from the North American Bison plant was present with discussion on the city furnishing water to the bison plant. Jacobson has visited with Central Plains Water District about the water with no results. City Attorney Peterson expressed that the Bison Plant must be the one to pursue the issue. If Central Plains Water District would open an opportunity, then the city could proceed. No action taken.

Ystaas moved to approve the revised Joint Powers Agreement Police Service Contract with Eddy County. Hager seconded. Motion carried.

Richter moved to approve the second reading of the Midco Franchise agreement ordinance. Ystaas seconded. In the discussion, several examples of cable lines hanging down were reviewed. In the vote, it was all against. Motion defeated. Ystaas will talk to Midco.

No one appeared to speak at the 2021 budget hearing. Hager moved to approve the 2021 budget as presented. Belquist seconded. In a roll call vote, all voted to approve. Motion carried.

PWS Hirschert was present with his monthly report. The city crews have been busy doing maintenance work around town. Hirschert has been busy with the water project. Two blocks of cast iron water lines were missed in the project and Hirschert has gotten some prices to install a new line. Hirschert will order the pipe incase the water line could be installed this year. The city crews have been filling in some of the catch basins to save money on the water line project. The sidewalk connecting the west side of Highway 281 to city sidewalk will be done when the water line project completes their concrete. The Brown Memorial roof is done but for the down spouts. The majority of the water meters will be updated when the water line project is completed. Ystaas moved to accept the report. McKnight seconded. Motion carried.

Kim Johnson has approached the city auditor about installing city water to his new building. The building is outside city limits, so no action taken.

The Central North Dakota Steam Threshers Reunion plan for addressing COVID-19 at their 2020 show was reviewed.

A letter from Marc Radke about his lead water line was reviewed. City Ordinances address the water line issue so no action was taken.

Hager moved to pay Interstate Engineering's bill of \$81,613.38 for the water project. Ystaas seconded. Motion carried.

McKnight moved to approve building permits for Chris Bichler, shingles, siding and windows; American Legion, cement driveway; Calvin Foster, steel roof; Haident Omoth, window and patio door; and Larry Danduran, windows, door, flooring. Richter seconded. Motion carried.

Hager moved to approve local gaming permits for NR Chamber of Commerce, American Legion Post #30, and Central ND Steam Threshers. Belquist seconded. Motion carried.

McKnight moved to approve a housing incentive for Kenneth Reis. Ystaas seconded. Motion carried.

The Board reviewed a Renaissance Zone Project for Rockford Plumbing and Heating. Ystaas moved to approve the Renaissance Zone project for Rockford Plumbing and Heating (Jacob Lommen). Hager seconded. Motion carried.

The City Auditor reported that the ND League of Cities will be holding a virtual 2020 annual conference. There was a discussion on the street project.

Richter moved to approve the CDBG for ATP Properties and Rockford Plumbing & Heating LLC. Ystaas seconded. Motion carried.

With no further business, Belquist moved to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 8:20 p.m. Minutes are subject to approval at the next regular Board meeting.
