of \$146,731. James Allmaras se-  
conded the motion, and the mo-  
tion carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**  
James Allmaras made a motion  
to select Interstate Engineering,  
Inc. to perform the preliminary  
and design engineering services  
for the structure replacement and  
structure removal Project BRJ-  
0014(050) PCN 23971. Glenda  
Collier seconded the motion, and  
the motion carried.

Candace Berg, Environmental  
Health Director for the Lake Re-  
gion District Health Unit, inspec-  
ted the bathrooms at Warsing  
Dam. One of the bathrooms is too  
close to the water and will need  
to be moved about 20 feet. The  
other bathroom was approved.  
Dave Chenze will continue the

tear down and construction of  
the bathroom that was approved.  
Discussion will be held at the next  
meeting as to plans for the move-  
ment of the other bathroom.

Todd Weber, Road Superinten-  
dent, gave an update that includ-  
ed how to handle improvements  
that need to be made on the  
elevator road and plans for con-  
struction of the new County shop  
in Sheyenne.  
Lisa Thompson, Emergency  
Manager, discussed the new re-  
quirements for the Emergency  
Management Performance Grant  
Program. The National Priority  
of Equity will be mandatory for  
this year. After discussion on the  
benefits of being in the program,  
Glenda Collier made a motion to  
not apply for the Emergency Man-  
agement Performance Grant. The  
motion was seconded by Dave  
Gehrtz, and the motion carried.

**NEW BUSINESS:**  
The hearing was held on the  
Application for Property Tax In-  
centives for Agronomy Solutions LLC  
DBA Hefty Seed. There was no  
public in attendance at the hear-  
ing. Glenda Collier made a motion  
to approve the 5-year property tax  
incentive for Agronomy Solutions  
LLC DBA Hefty Seed. James Al-  
lmaras seconded the motion, and  
the motion carried.

At 9:00 A.M., the County  
Equalization Meeting was held.  
There were no County taxpayers  
present. Kristy O'Connor, Tax Di-  
rector, presented her 2023 equal-  
ization report. The Eddy County  
Soils Committee approved a 5%  
increase in cropland and a 2% in-  
crease in non-cropland valuation  
for 2023. Glenda Collier made a  
motion to accept the equalization  
report and County valuations as  
presented. The motion was se-  
conded by James Allmaras, and  
the motion carried.

Kevin Johnson, Central ND  
Steam Threshers, attended the  
meeting to request additional  
funding for mowing at the fair-  
grounds. Dave Gehrtz made a  
motion to pay Central ND Steam  
Threshers \$1,500 for mowing  
costs. The motion was seconded  
by Glenda Collier, and the motion  
carried.

The Commissioners meeting in  
July will be held on July 5, 2023,  
at 8:30 A.M.

Glenda Collier made a motion  
to accept the quote received  
from SPX Aids to Navigation, LLC  
for a new lighting system for the  
County tower in the amount of  
\$6,249.51. James Allmaras se-  
conded the motion, and the mo-  
tion carried. Great Plains Towers  
estimated that the installation will  
be around \$5,600.

James Allmaras made a mo-  
tion to approve the Tower Lease  
Agreement Renewal with High  
Plains Equipment, Inc. for year  
2023 in the amount of \$800.  
Glenda Collier seconded the mo-  
tion, and the motion carried.

James Allmaras made a motion  
to approve the fairgrounds Lease  
Agreement with Shawna Lommen  
for July 28, 2023, through July 30,  
2023, for a wedding reception.  
Glenda Collier seconded the mo-  
tion, and the motion carried.

Glenda Collier made a motion  
to approve the prorated single  
insurance premium for Rebecca  
Anderson of \$203.33 for June and  
\$258.99 for each month thereaf-  
ter until the rates increase. The  
motion was seconded by James  
Allmaras, and the motion carried.  
Commissioner James Allmaras  
left the meeting at 10:00 A.M.

The Commissioners reviewed the  
2024 salary chart and discus-  
sioned cost-of-living increases.  
The Salary Survey Participant  
Report that Eddy County was  
a part of was reviewed. Glenda  
Collier made a motion to raise all  
Sheriff deputies, the road super-  
intendent, and the states attorney  
two steps on the pay plan plus a  
4% cost-of-living increase, to not  
raise the Sheriff and Sheriff office  
deputy, and to raise all other em-  
ployees one step on the pay plan  
plus a 4% cost-of-living increase.  
Dave Gehrtz seconded the mo-  
tion, and the motion carried.

Dave Gehrtz, Chairperson, ad-  
joined the meeting at 10:10 A.M.  
The next regular meeting will  
be July 5, 2023, at 8:30 A.M.
