### NEW ROCKFORD-SHEYENNE PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2 REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

MONDAY, AUGUST 14TH, 2023 AT 7:00 P.M.

Members present: Todd Allmaras, Mike Schaefer, Eric Perleberg, Mary Kay Price, Mike Jacobson (via Zoom), Patti Larson, Kyle Alfstad. Others present: Dr. Jill Louters, Superintendent; Natalie Becker, Principal; Dave Skogen, Business Manager.

President Allmaras called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**Approval of the Agenda**  
It was moved by Price and seconded by Jacobson to approve the agenda as presented.

**Approval of the July 10th Regular & July 28th, and August 3rd 2023 Special Meeting Minutes**  
It was moved by Schaefer and seconded by Price to approve the minutes of the July 10th regular meeting minutes and the July 28th and August 3rd special meeting as presented.

Motion carried unanimously.

**Approval of the Consent Agenda**  
It was moved by Alfstad and seconded by Perleberg to approve the consent agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously. The consent agenda consisted of the business manager report, and the bills - general fund of \$86,243.88, and the building fund of \$13,437.25.

**Monthly Committee Reports**  
There were no committee meetings this month.

**Principals' Reports**  
Elementary Principal Becker presented her report to the board. Final preparations for back school including launch week, PowerSchool updates, sorting of curriculum to classrooms, and back to school staff meetings are well underway. Principal Becker also noted professional development work in the areas of PBIS, Best in Class grant meetings and LETRS trainings have been or will be completed in the near future.

**Superintendent Report**  
Superintendent Louters shared her report with the board. Preparation and completion of Launch week lead to great conversations about teacher evaluations. This is the first year of Launch week, where new staff are able to go through a revised orientation led by administration and current staff touching on every aspect of the school system. Work in supports for secondary staff are underway featuring curriculum development standard review and CTE programming including research and ordering. Lastly Dr. Louters noted continued work with PACE and Icon pertaining to the Second Gym Project fundraising and planning efforts.

**Teacher Report**  
There was no teacher report this morning.

**Student Report**  
There was no student report this morning.

**Teacher Lane Changes**  
It was moved by Larson and seconded by Perleberg to approve the lane changes for Lynnae Lies and Tasha Skogen. Motion carried unanimously. Each teacher provided evidence of continuing education credits to warrant the lane change, changing their salary on the previously signed contract for the '23-'24 year.

**APPROVE CONSOLIDATED APPLICATION BUDGET**  
It was moved by Alfstad and seconded by Larson to approve the Consolidated Application Budget as presented. Motion carried unanimously. On an annual basis the district prepares a budget for the Title funds the district previously applied for and was awarded. This budget upon approval is submitted to NDDPI for their approval.

**Preliminary Budget**  
BM Skogen presented the updated preliminary budget to the board. The presentation focused more on how and where the budget is centered, the greatest changes from the year before and areas of strength, areas to watch, and areas of flexibility.

**School Board Professional Development**  
It was moved by Jacobson and seconded by Alfstad to submit the Be Legendary Grant application. Motion carried unanimously. Dr. Louters presented to the board a couple options for school board training. The Be Legendary School Board Institute training, as well as a proposal from Schatz and Associates. Dr. Schatz recently facilitated the districts strategic planning process. After discussion the motion was made to submit a grant application for the Be Legendary training. If granted the board would receive a discounted rate for the training.

**Signature Stamp**  
It was moved by Larson and seconded by Price to approve the addition of a facsimile signature stamp for Todd Allmaras, to the previously approved signature card. Motion carried unanimously. The signature stamp can only be used in approved circumstances, mainly sports meet fees and officials, and with no check exceeding \$500.00.

**Policy Review - Policy JBA**  
No motion on the table tonight as item is for review only, as part of the districts continued review process. Policy JBA ensures the public that the district will comply with the accessibility standards outlined in federal and state law based on the Americans with Disabilities Act. Policy will now list 8/14/23 as a review date.
