Chapter 11-10.2, to change the currently elected offices of Eddy County Auditor and Treasurer to appointed offices. As required by state law, the plan for the imple mentation of this change is pub-lished below. The Eddy County Commission will be holding public hearings regarding the adoption of a final resolution in this matter on March 26, 2024 at 9:00 a.m. and April 2, 2024 at 9:00 a.m., both in the Commissioner's Meeting Room in the basement of the Eddy County Courthouse. Interested parties are invited to attend or submit written comments to the Eddy County Commission, Attn.: Becki Schumacher, 524 Central Ave, New Rockford, ND 58356, prior to that time

PLAN FOR REDESIGNATION OF THE OFFICE OF EDDY COUNTY AUDITOR AND TREASURER TO APPOINTED POSITIONS

The Eddy County Commission has resolved to consider the redesignation of the currently elected offices of Eddy County Auditor and Treasurer to appointed offic-es. Currently, the Auditor's and Treasurer's positions are elected. There are no minimum qualifications for any person to run for these positions, other than being a resident of Eddy County at least eighteen (18) years of age. Making these positions appointed will ensure the County has the most

qualified people in these roles. Specifically, the Auditor is tasked with acting as the Chief Financial Officer for the County, which includes handling taxes and budgeting. The Auditor is also the Election Administrator for all primary, general and special county, state and federal elec-tions. Finally, the Auditor is the secretary for the County Com-There are numerous other responsibilities for the Auditor that extend to maintaining inventories, ensuring insurance coverage, verifying daily cash sheets of the County Treasurer,

and issuing licenses and permits.

Likewise, the Treasurer has significant financial and recordkeeping duties, which include: receiving all monies belonging to the County, paying all bills for the County, keeping all financial logs for receipts and disbursements, making tax distributions to townships, investing County funds, reconciling bank statements, preparing and mailing real estate taxes, and handling delinquent taxes on real estate taxes.

Both of the positions have significant responsibilities that cover the financial affairs of the County. Keeping them elected means any adult, resident could run for the position without having the most minute amount of financial educations. In order to ensure the best, most qualified and educated persons are in charge of the County's finances, the Commission desires to require an applicant for these positions to have prior accounting experience and training in the accounting field. namely a four (4) year account-ing degree or CPA licensure. This minimum requirement will ensure the County is run efficiently and effectively while promoting ac-countability to the citizens. Recently, there was a vacancy

in the Auditor's Office. In a County of over two-thousand people, only two applications were received for the position. As the current elected model requires a candidate to reside in Eddy County, it could be missing the best candidates due to living a mile or so from the County line. In the appointed model, the County would give preference to an applicant living in Eddy County, but would ultimately base its hiring decision on ensuring Eddy County's financial affairs are being managed by the most trained and qualified person.

The Commission desires that this change will take effect no later than April 1st and May 1st, 2027, which is when the current four-year terms of the Auditor and Treasurer, respectively, would ex-


