





The grant funding comes through the recent special section HB 1505. The existing bridge was reconstructed in 1970 and is a single span adjacent Box Beam structure. Two spalls on bridge deck are patched with asphalt. Spall on abutment face of NW corner of north abutment underneath beam seat of box girder. Northwest corner has a 2-foot diameter broken section of concrete on the north abutment. Tilt on the abutments is SW -4.5% and SE -3.8% tilt back. NE -1.8% and NW 1.1% tilt back.
